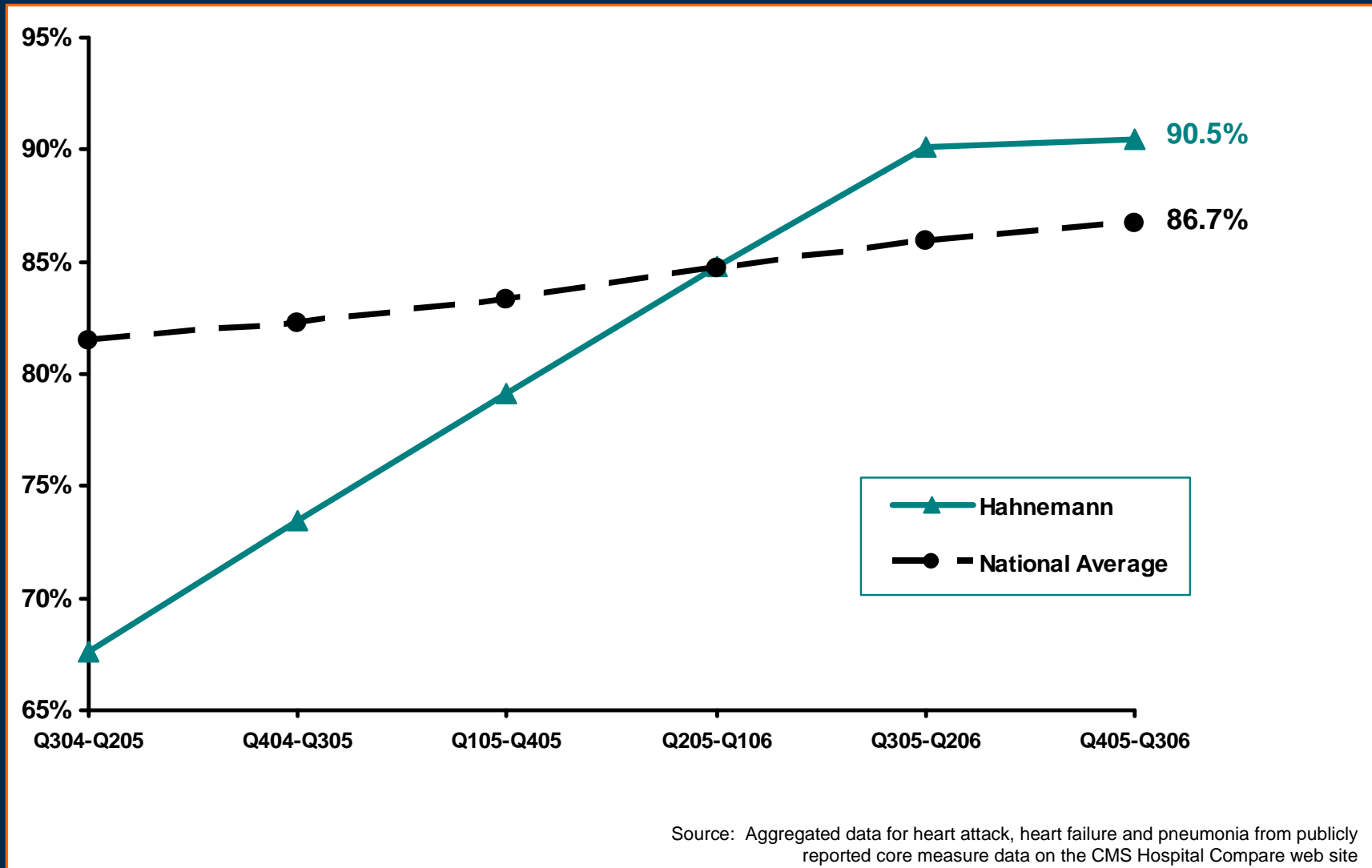


QUALITY

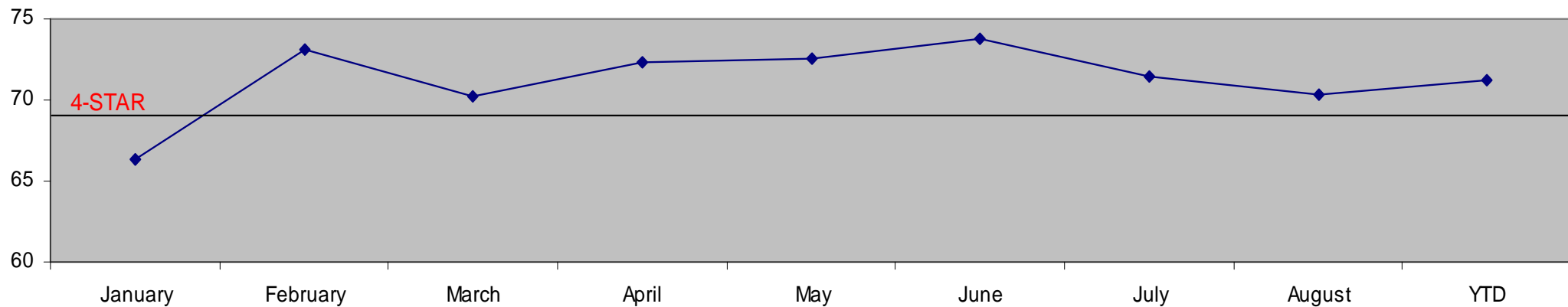
How Hahnemann Compares on Quality
